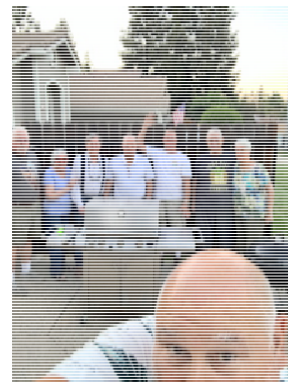

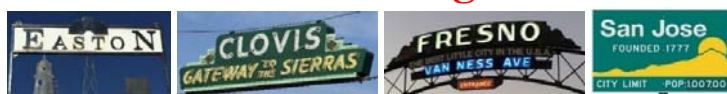

We each have other individuals who need to be in our prayers; those with illness, loss of loved ones, and cancer.

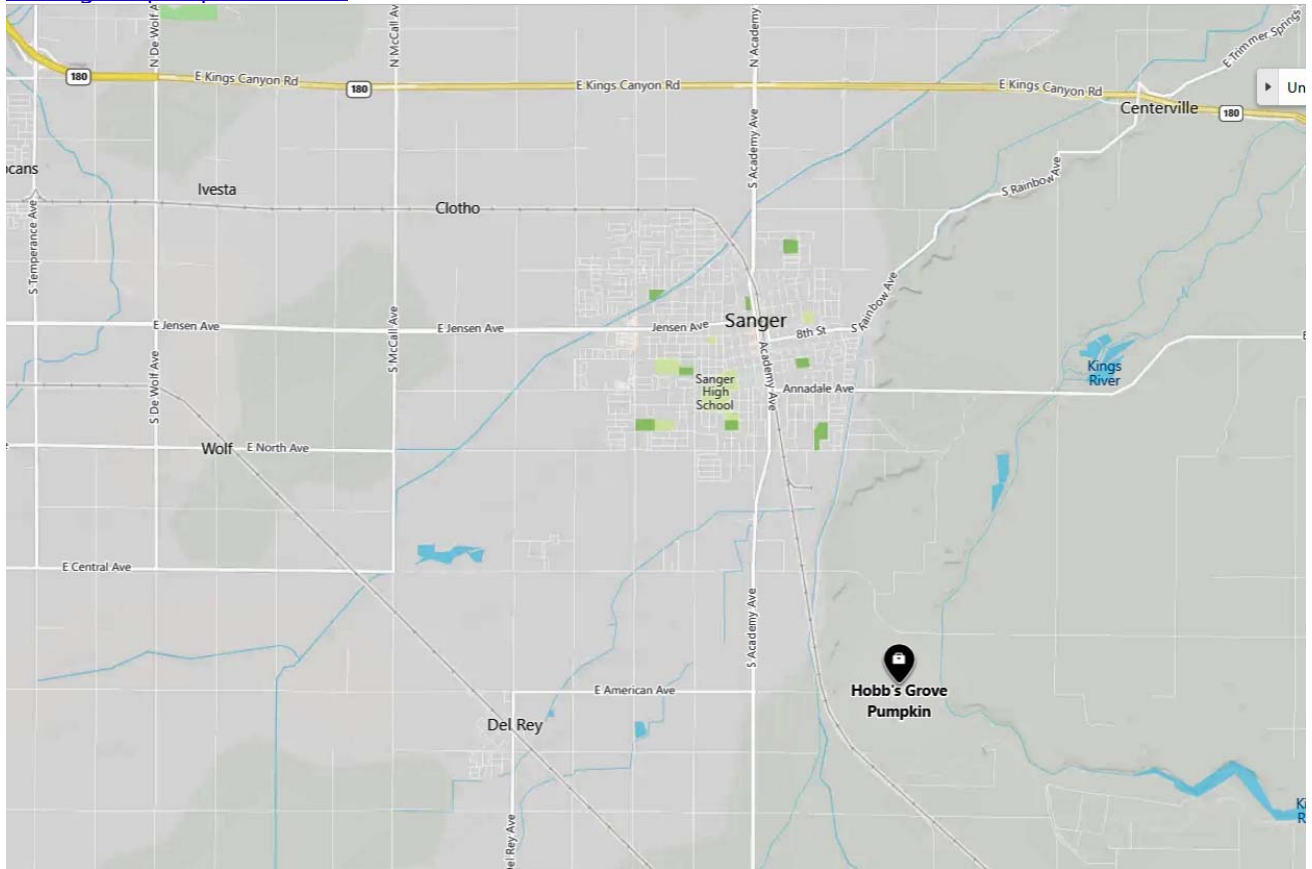
Pray for our Nation and US President Biden and Vice President Harris.

Our prayers continue for those in our Armed Forces, present and past, and their families. Pray for peace to come in so many troubled lands.

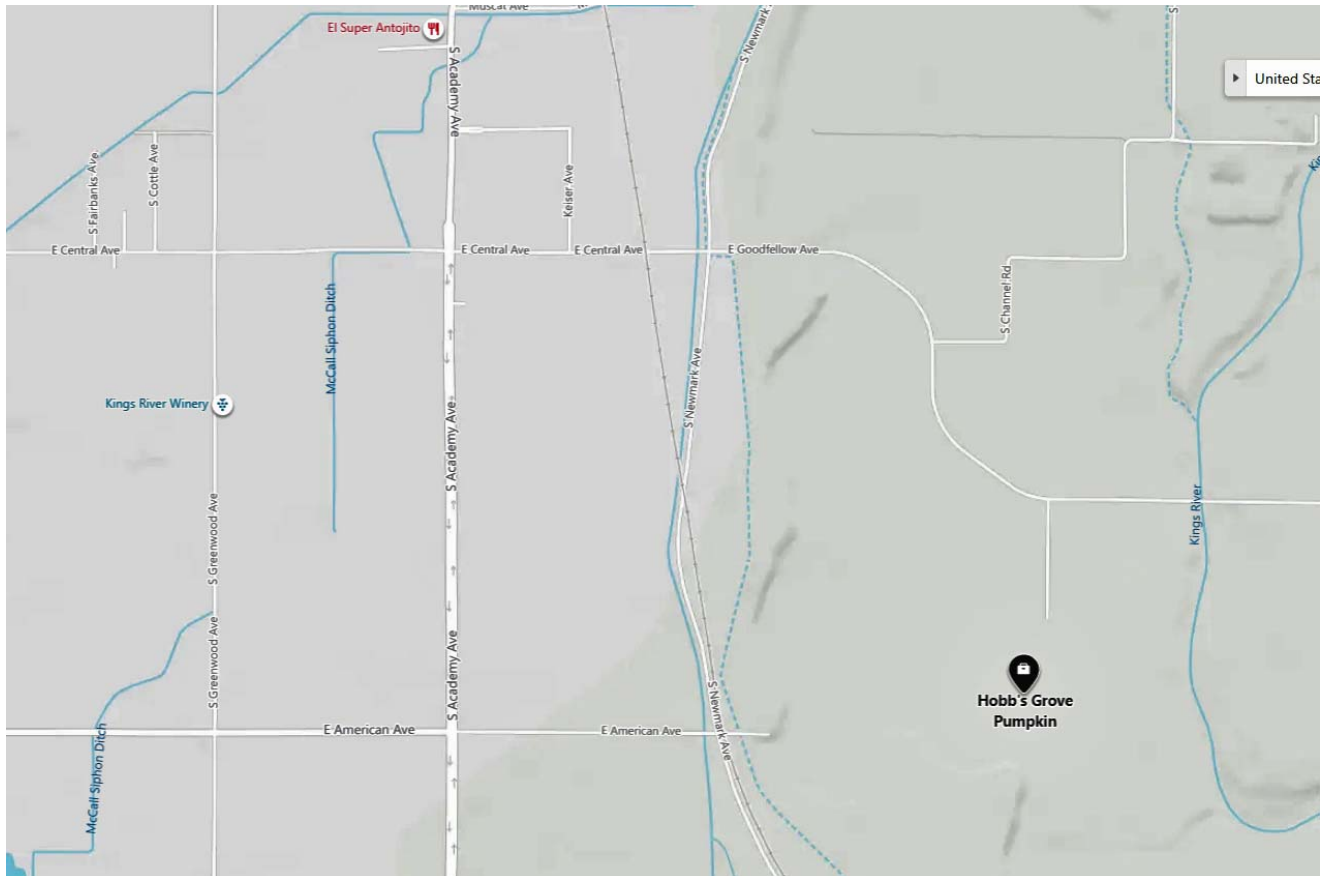
